



Notification of Parents' Rights

Welcome to Runge ISD! We value your partnership in the education of your children. As part of our commitment to transparency and collaboration, we are pleased to inform you of your parental rights under Chapter 26 of the Texas Education Code. These rights are essential for ensuring your active involvement in your child's education.

1. Parent Involvement and Rights

You have the right to be full partners with schools in the education of your children.

2. Access to Student Records

You can access all written records of your children, including attendance, test scores, grades, disciplinary records, counseling records, and psychological records.

3. Right to Information

You have the right to request information about the qualifications of your child's teachers and the school's performance and accreditation status.

4. Participation in Educational Processes

You can review all teaching materials, textbooks, and other teaching aids used in the classroom.

You have the right to access state assessments and request information about the purpose of various school activities.

5. Exemptions from Instruction

You can temporarily remove your child from a class or activity that conflicts with your religious or moral beliefs.

6. Right to Complain

You can file a complaint regarding the denial of any rights outlined in Chapter 26, and the school district will provide a timely response.

7. Access to School Board Meetings

You are allowed to attend and participate in school board meetings.

8. School Choice

You have options regarding your child's attendance at a specific school, including transfers and charter schools.
