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Runge ISD Families,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you about updates to district procedures related to restrooms, locker rooms, and changing facilities. These updates are required under **Texas Senate Bill 8 (2025)**, which becomes effective on **December 4, 2025**, and applies to all public schools in Texas.

SB 8 requires that all multi-occupancy restrooms, locker rooms, showers, and similar facilities in publicly owned buildings be designated for use according to a person's **biological sex assigned at birth**. Runge ISD will follow the law while continuing to ensure that every student is treated with dignity, respect, and care.

## What This Means for Students

- Multi-occupancy restrooms and locker rooms will be designated as **Male** or **Female**, as required by state law.
- Each campus will continue to provide at least one **single-occupancy**, **gender-neutral restroom** for any student who prefers additional privacy.
- Students may request to use a private facility at any time and **do not need to provide personal or medical information** to do so.
- Harassment, bullying, or teasing related to restroom or locker-room use will not be tolerated and will be addressed under the Student Code of Conduct.

## **Athletics and Locker Rooms**

Runge ISD has also updated procedures for coach access to locker rooms to protect student privacy:

- Coaches will supervise locker rooms according to the sex of the team.
- A coach of the opposite sex may enter a locker room **only after all students are fully dressed** or if an emergency requires immediate action.
- Students who prefer a private place to change may request a single-occupancy restroom or a private changing area.

These procedures follow UIL expectations and best practices to protect student safety and privacy.

## **Our Commitment**

While SB 8 establishes clear legal requirements, our approach continues to reflect Runge ISD's core values:

- Safety-ensuring students feel secure in all district facilities
- **Respect**-treating every student with dignity
- Support-providing private options when needed
- Compliance-following state law while maintaining a positive school climate
